## General Principles of the World Alliance for Breastfeeding Action

- Breastfeeding is a universal right of all mothers and infants. WABA shall work to protect, promote and support this right worldwide.
- WABA shall support the <u>Innocenti Declaration</u><sup>1</sup> and the <u>WHO/UNICEF Global</u>
  <u>Strategy for Infant and Young Child Feeding</u><sup>2</sup> and shall act to achieve their operational targets.
- WABA shall support the ending of all promotion of breastmilk substitutes and infant and young child feeding products as in the <u>International Code of Marketing</u> <u>of Breastmilk Substitutes and subsequent relevant World Health Assembly</u> Resolutions<sup>3</sup>.
- WABA does not accept funds (salary, grants, scholarships, donations, etc.) or gifts from manufacturers or distributors of breastmilk substitutes, infant and young child feeding products, feeding bottles and teats.
