Invitation to become an Affiliate and Partner of WABA

WABA has played a key role in the protection, promotion and support of breastfeeding worldwide. All this has been achieved with dedicated support from individuals and organisations like you. The breastfeeding landscape has changed over the last decades with more actors, and increasingly more complex challenges. WABA has to move with the tide and has undergone a restructuring. We invite you to become part of the restructured WABA.

After 28 years of existence, an extensive governance review was conducted to examine and revamp our partnership and network model. A more inclusive structure with diverse partners will enable greater participation, new approaches and enhanced collaboration. This will improve WABA's responsiveness as an alliance and lead to greater impact. The culmination of the governance review is the current <u>WABA Working Principles of July 2020</u>.

In the current WABA Working Principles, Endorsers will now be called "Affiliates" (Individual and Organisational Affiliates). Affiliates will continue to have the privilege of submitting nominees to the WABA Steering Council (SC). Individual Affiliates can also nominate and stand for elections to the Steering Council. Organisational Affiliates can also become Partners at global, regional or country levels and collaborate more closely with WABA. The <u>WABA Rules of Engagement</u> and the <u>Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)</u> specify the details of the criteria, privileges, conditions and responsibilities of Affiliates and Partners.

How to become a WABA Affiliate and Partner

Affiliates will be required to submit an application form and to pay <u>annual dues</u>. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and its consequences for many individuals and organisations, WABA offers to waive the membership due for the first year for all individuals and organisations who join WABA by Monday, 14 September 2020. Those who join by 14 September 2020 will be entitled to nominate candidates for the upcoming SC elections and Individual Affiliates may stand for the SC elections. For Organisational Affiliates, you can also indicate in the same form if you want to sign up as a Partner of WABA. Please click <u>here</u> to apply to become a WABA Affiliate and Organisational Partner.
